Tips for Success

- Make a habit to regularly check Canvas and Powerschool! Earth Science Binders

For this class you will need a 1½ inch binder. It is your responsibility to bring your binder **EVERYDAY**. Your binder should NOT stay at school<u>or</u> at home. Bring it everyday. Your binder will need to stay organized with notes, handouts & activities. Binder checks will be done regularly! This syllabus should be the FIRST document in your binder!!!

Grading Policy:

- 1. All students have the ability to make up any missed work due to an excused absence. Students should contact their teacher and collect all missed assignments. All make up work is due to the student's respective teacher within 5 business days of their absence! If an assignment is not completed and turned in; those missed assignments turn into a zero.
- 2. Per CMS Grading Policy; a 50% will be assigned as the lowest grade for any assignment for which the student shows a reasonable attempt to address the minimum requirements of the task; this means the student actually did the task but did not meet the minimum requirement.
