CMS Grading Breakdown

- 2. **Rehearse (30%):** Assignments that provide students with feedback on progress towards mastery of standards (i.e. quizzes, labs, mini-assessments, mini-projects, classwork)
- 3. **Perform(50%):** Culminating/formative assessment that measure mastery of one or multiple standards (i.e. unit assessments and projects with rubrics).
